Real, authentic relationships...

I. Are built upon shared VALUES . (v.1)

One in spirit / knit = *“knotted, tied together, bound to”*

II. Are SELFLESS and GENEROUS in nature. (v.1-4, 23:15-18; 2 Samuel 9:1-12)

David and Jonathan’s friendship was characterized by two key things: a selfless nature and a generous spirit.

III. Are focused on GOD . (I Sam.18:3, 20:16, 23:18; Ecclesiastes 4:9-12)

A covenant relationship is a union between two parties where God is invited to play a key role not just in each person’s life but in the relationship itself.
