Admonish / Noutheteo = *“To warn, to caution.”*

Teaching / Didasko = *“to instruct, to hold discourse with others and to conduct oneself as a teacher.”*

IV. **DEPEND** upon Christ. (v.29)

Labor / Kopiaio = *“to grow weary, tired, exhausted; to labor with wearisome effort.”*

Struggling / agonizomai = *“to contend with adversaries, to fight, to wrestle with difficulties and dangers.”*
