Sermon Notes (continued)

- II. Baptism and the Lord’s Supper serve as **REMINDERS** of who saves us: Jesus Christ (v.13-15; Hebrews 9:22).

- I. **RITES** and **RITUALS** cannot and will not save us (v.11-12; Deut. 10:16, 30:6; Jer. 4:4, Acts 7:51; Gal. 6:13-16).

Deuteronomy 10:16 -- *“Circumcise then your heart, and stiffen your neck no more.”*

Deuteronomy 30:6 -- *“Moreover the Lord your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your descendants, to love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, in order that you may live.”*

Jeremiah 4:4 -- *“Circumcise yourselves to the LORD, and take away the foreskin of your hearts.”*

Acts 7:51 -- Stephen accused the religious leaders of the day of being, *“men who are stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart.”*

Galatians 6:13-16 -- *“May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. Neither circumcision nor uncircumcision means anything; what counts is a new creation.”*

- ◇ This week I will pray daily and thank God for His love and for my salvation.
